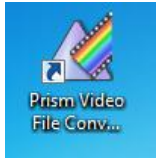


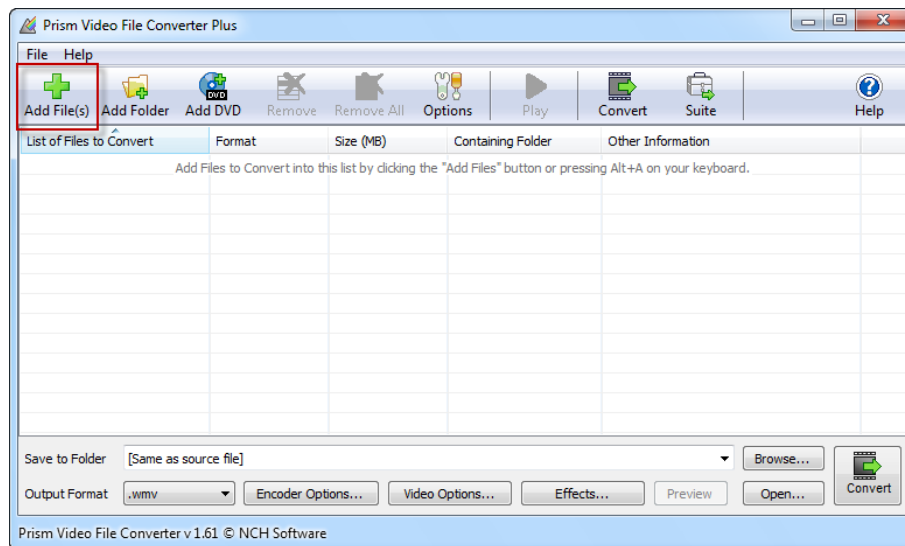
# CONVERTING INTO OTHER VIDEO FORMATS

You will need a video conversion program. I'm using Prism from NCH Software which cost \$25.00. The software can be purchased at: <http://www.nchsoftware.com/prism/index.html>

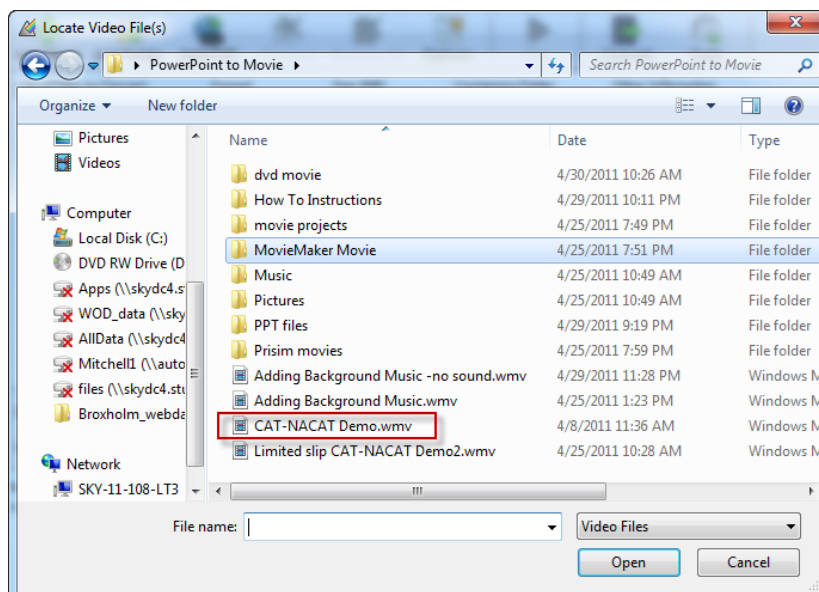
1. Once installed double click on the Prism desktop icon.



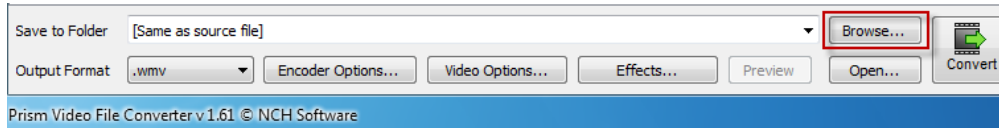
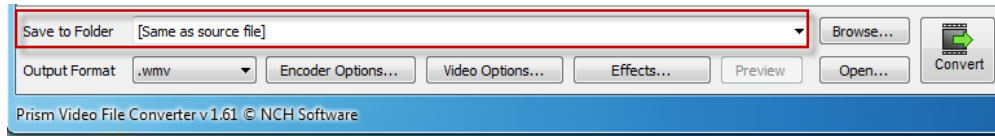
2. Click on "Add Files"



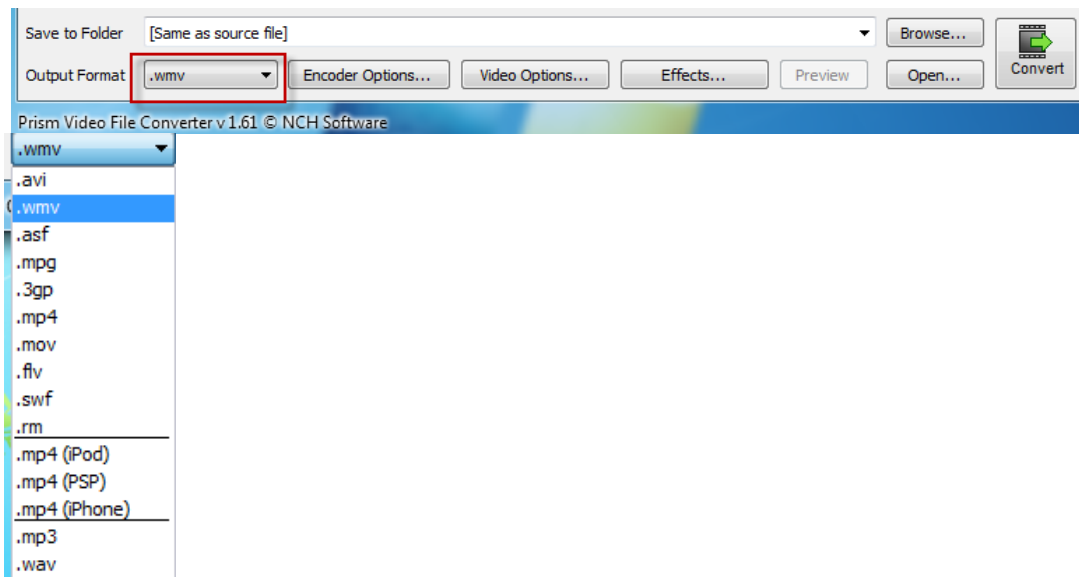
3. Locate the file you want to convert. Select it and click on "Open"



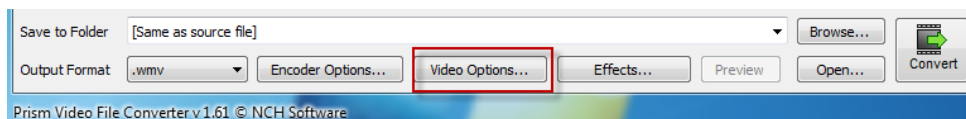
4. Select the save folder location. You can choose between 2 defaults or you can browse to a location of your choice.



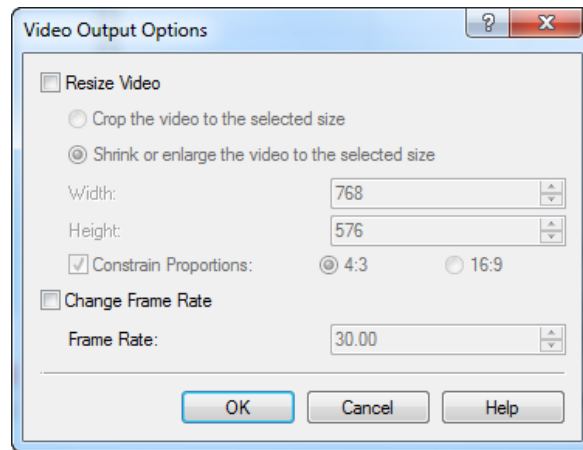
5. Choose the "Output Format" that you want to convert to. MP4 format is the choice for MAC compatibility.



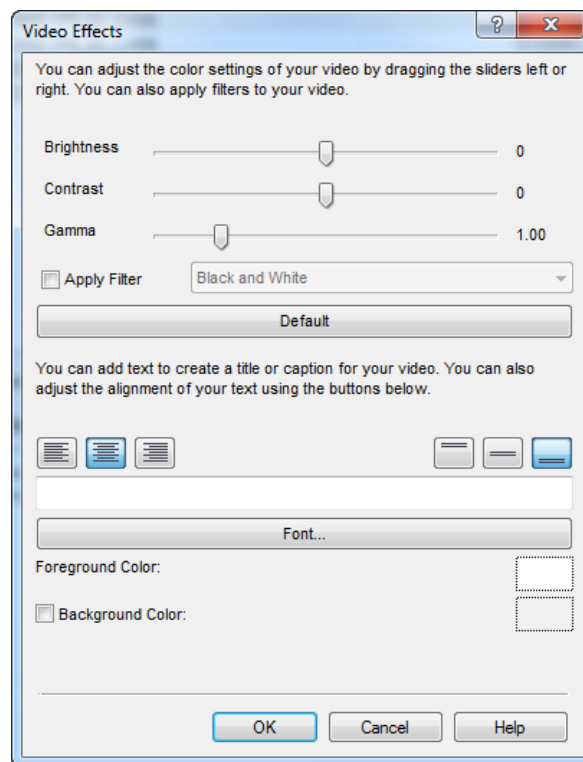
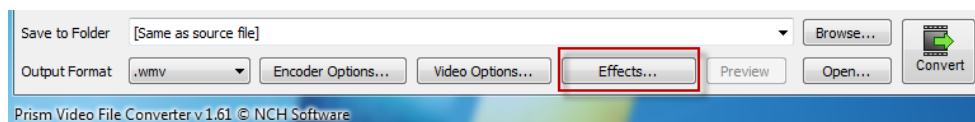
6. If you wish you can change some of the "Video Options"



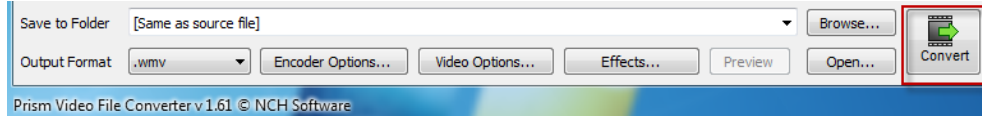
8. Here you can change the output size and the frame rate. Most normally don't change these settings. Lowering the video size and frame rate will affect the file size and quality.



9. You can change some of the Effects with this button.

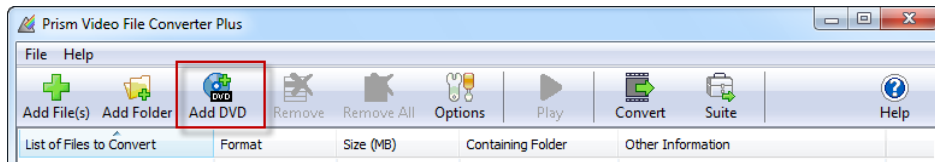


11. Click on “ Convert ” to convert the file

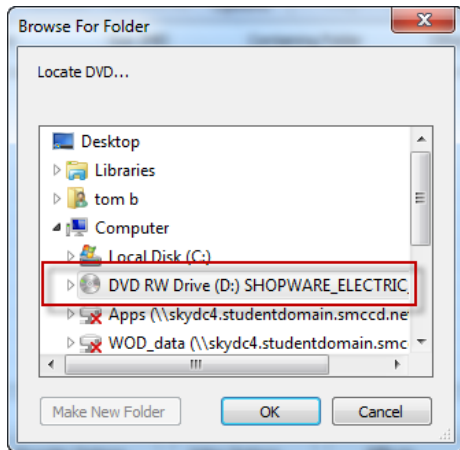


12. To convert commercial DVD files there are two ways to choose your DVD files.

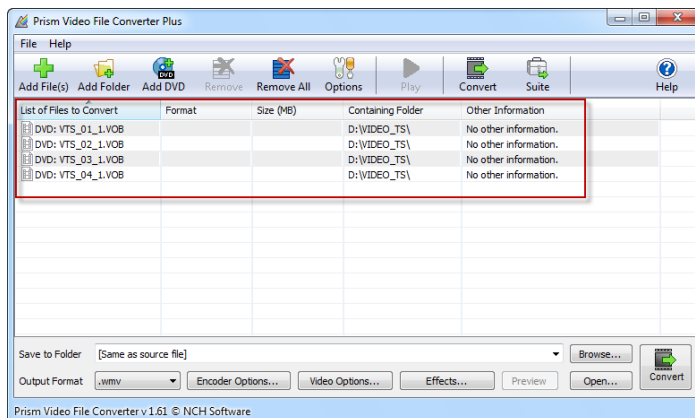
13. Option 1, click the “ Add DVD ” button on the ribbon bar.



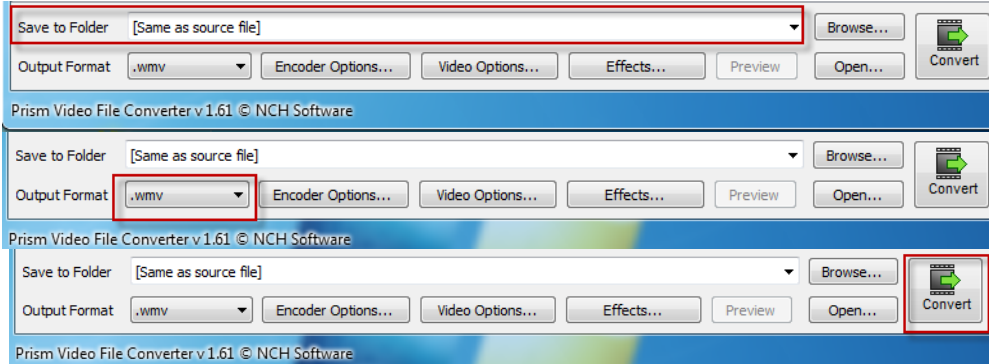
14. Select “DVD” from the folder list.



15. The DVD video files will populate the file list.

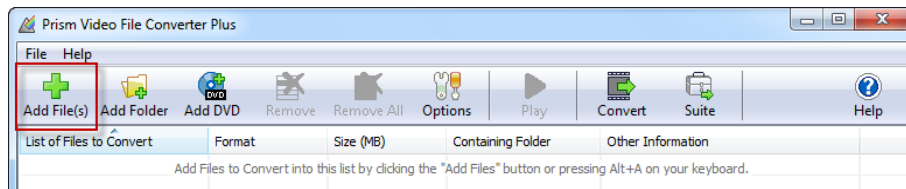


16. Choose the output file location and Output file format. Click on “Convert”.

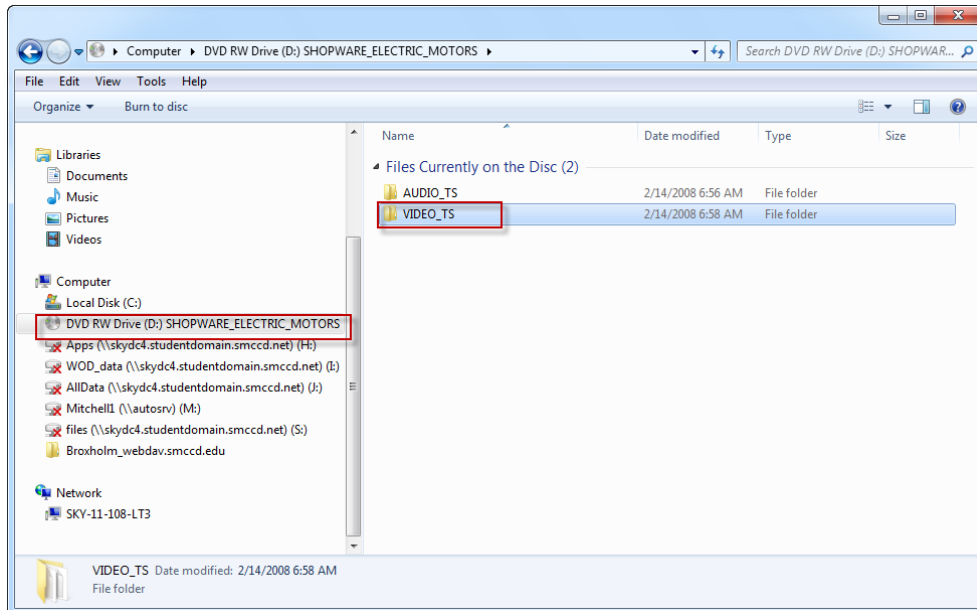

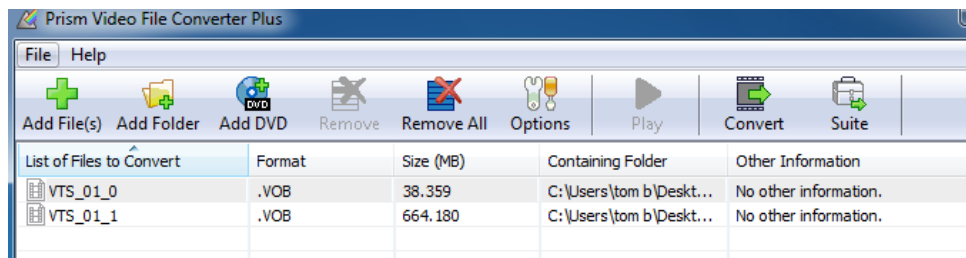
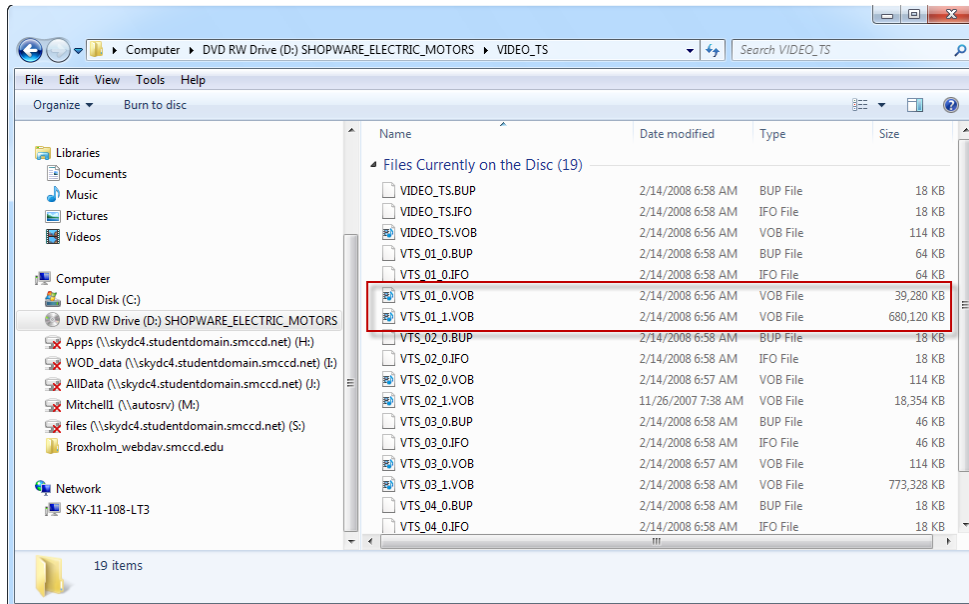
18. Click on “Add Files”
